Following the TAG meeting, Duke Energy Carolinas and their Independent Entity (the Midwest ISO) invite you stay to receive a report on the Duke Energy Annual Transmission Plan and provide them feedback on their Plan. This meeting is scheduled from 3:00 – 4:00 PM in the same location as the TAG meeting in the NCEMC office.
