SUBJECT: Requesting Evaluation of an Enhanced Transmission Access Option
DATE: February 7, 2006

A preliminary overview of the Enhanced Transmission Access planning process was presented at the February 3rd TAG meeting. The purpose of the Enhanced Transmission Access planning process is to evaluate the means to increase transmission access to potential resources inside and outside the Duke and Progress control areas to serve load in North Carolina. The first step of this process is for the Participants and the TAG members to propose scenarios and interfaces for analysis in 2006. The Planning Work Group (PWG) will review all the proposed scenarios / interfaces and provide the Oversight Steering Committee (OSC) a recommendation on the Enhanced Transmission Access options for analysis in 2006. The OSC will provide feedback to the TAG during the 2nd quarter of 2006 concerning the Enhanced Transmission Access options to be included in the analysis.

The form to be used by the Participants and the TAG members to propose scenarios and interfaces to be studied is attached and is also posted on the North Carolina Transmission Planning Collaborative (NCTPC) website (www.nctpc.org/nctpc) under TAG Working Documents.
